Breach Security Inc. has reviewed its internal processes with regard to handling of the email addresses gathered at BlackHat 2009. These addresses were uploaded directly into two well known marketing industry ASP sites under our private accounts. Both of these ASP have industry standard security and strong privacy policies in place.

Upon inquiry to both of these vendor ASPs regarding this report, one of them has indicated that it may have been subject to a data breach and they have an on-going internal investigation into the possible event. They have also contacted the FBI for further assistance. To the extent that your organization can provide us with more specific information on the email address in question we would be happy to provide this to the vendor in question to aid in their investigation.

Breach Security Inc. values and respects the customer's or prospective customer's expectation of confidentiality. Safeguarding the non-public personal information and the confidential financial information of our customers is essential in maintaining the public trust. It is the policy of Breach Security Inc. that such confidential information acquired by the company or its employees through their employment must be held in the strictest confidence. Such information is to be held for Breach Security Inc. internal purposes only and not as a basis for gain by the company or any employee. As a condition of employment, each employee is required to read and agree to this policy by signing a Patent, Copyright and Nondisclosure Agreement. The original signed copy of each employee's Agreement is retained in his or her personnel file.

We will be reviewing the additional preventative security steps taken by this specific vendor to assure that these problems do not happen again. We appreciate your organization's efforts to pursue these reports; data security is an effort that we at Breach Security commit ourselves fully.
