Nocona General Hospital Discovered Data Security Incident

Nocona – Nocona General Hospital discovered data security incident.

Nocona General Hospital recently learned of a criminal cyber attack which enabled hackers to access certain file folders on its computer network. Upon learning of this incident, Nocona General Hospital immediately launched an investigation to more clearly understand its scope. Because the hackers gained access to Nocona General Hospital's network, the hackers are believed to have accessed information in certain folders which may have included names, gender, ages, dates of birth, addresses, Social Security numbers, diagnosis information, procedure descriptions, or procedure codes.

On April 30, 2021, Nocona General Hospital mailed notification letters to those patients who may have been affected by this incident. The letters will provide recommendations on how affected individuals may protect themselves. Nocona General Hospital encourages affected individuals to remain vigilant by monitoring their personal information. Additional information may be found in the notification letters.

Nocona General Hospital plans to implement additional safeguards to further strengthen data security, and assess its privacy and security controls to prevent future incidents such as this.

Nocona General Hospital takes its patients' privacy and the security of information very seriously and deeply regrets any inconvenience this incident may have caused.
